The Declaration of 24 November 2008 of the President of the UN General Assembly on the "Question of Palestine" made explicit reference to apartheid, insofar as Israeli policies in the occupied Palestinian territory resembled the regime that existed in another era and another continent, South Africa.

As in the case of South African apartheid, civil society has adopted a peaceful movement of boycott, divestment and sanctions in order to pressure Israel to stop committing human rights violations against the Palestinian people.
